



BIO 442 INTERNSHIP IN BIOLOGY (Undergraduate Students)

BIO 442 Internship in Biology (6 ECTS)

This course involves laboratory or field research supervised by a faculty member of the Department of Biological Sciences. Only students with superior academic performance are eligible for this course. Student assessment is based on a ten-minute public presentation of the lab/field work results in front of his/her Academic Advisor and Internship Supervisor. Students may sign up for this course after completion of their second year of studies, but not concurrently with their diploma thesis research.

Prerequisites:

1. The student must have attained a Grade Point average of at least 8.00 during the first two years of study.
2. The student must have completed successfully at least 19 courses during the first two years of study.
3. The Academic Advisor, the faculty member that will supervise the internship ('Supervisor') and the Departmental Committee of Undergraduate Studies must approve the student's application for the course. In order to sign up for the course, students must first obtain the written approval of their academic advisor and the supervising faculty. The printed form completely filled in and with all signatures must be delivered at the Department's Secretariat. The Secretariat will forward it to the Department's Undergraduate Studies Committee for final approval.

The Supervisor must also submit to the aforementioned Committee a short description of the proposed research project, which should be different from a possible future project for a diploma thesis that the student may conduct or has already conducted in the same lab.

Grades of BIO 442

The BIO 442 course receives grades from 0 to 10, by ½ units.
