STRUCTURE AND GUIDELINES

(Internal Regulation of BIO Department)

The dissertation text (Master's level) can be written in Greek or in any international language.

The structure of the dissertation should be in accordance with the following guidelines:

- A title page.
- A page with the Examination Committee.
- A summary in Greek and in English, not longer than 500 words each.
- Introduction
- Materials and Methods
- Results & Discussion (preferably as two separate chapters)
- Acknowledgements.
- Contents.
- Abbreviations' list (if applied).
- References.

Other guidelines

- The Harvard bibliography standard should be followed (according to which, the journal's name should be in italics and the author(s) name(s) in capitals. The Harvard bibliography standard is included as 'Output Style' in Endnote software).
- The text should have a 1.5 space between lines, the fonts should be (similar to) Times 12pt, and the page margins should be 2cm (upper, lower and right) and 3.5cm (left).
- At the beginning of the dissertation the following should be explicitly mentioned:
Starting date of postgraduate studies
Starting date of research stage
Name of Research Advisor (Supervisor)

Copy of the Dissertation

A copy of the dissertation is submitted in electronic form, as pdf file, to the Department's Secretariat and to the Research Advisor.
