**POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES PLACES FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2008-2009**

The University of Cyprus announces that it accepts applications for a limited number of places in the following postgraduate programmes beginning in September 2008:

**DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRICAL AND COMPUTER ENGINEERING (ECE)**

(a) Thirty-two (**32**) positions for the postgraduate programme in **Electrical Engineering** which are distributed as follows:

- Twenty (**20**) positions at the **Master's** level
- Twelve(**12**) positions at the **PhD** level

(b) Eighteen (**18**) positions for the postgraduate programme in **Computer Engineering** which are distributed as follows:

- Ten (**10**) positions at the **Master's** level
- Eight (**8**) positions at the **PhD** level

## FEES

### Postgraduate Programme: Master's Degree

1. Master Programmes offered in Greek: €5.125 (£3000) per programme
2. Master in Business Administration (**MBA**): €10.251 (£6000)

### Postgraduate Programme: PhD Degree

1. Stage 1 Didactic : €427 (£250) per course
2. Stage 2 Research : €854 (£500) per semester
3. Stage 3 Written : €170 (£100) per semester

### Note:-

1. **The research stage of PhD** lasts at least **4 semesters**. Consequently the minimum total sum that should be paid is **€3416** (£2.000).
2. **Research stages 1 and 2** are carried out at the same time with the didactic stage from the third semester of study onwards. If the student takes no exemption from the didactic stage of the program, this stage should be the only stage carried out during the first two semesters of study. In case of partial exemption from the didactic part of program, then the research stages can begin at the same time with the didactic stage from the first semester of study. Students, who take complete exemption from the didactic stage, may begin with the research stage, from the very beginning of their study.
3. If a PhD student **fails** a course, he/she should pay the sum of: **€427** (£250) per course.
