ANNOUNCEMENT OF ACADEMIC POSITIONS

The University of Cyprus announces two (2) academic positions at the rank of Assistant Professor or Lecturer.

DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL AND ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING

One position at the rank of Assistant Professor or Lecturer in the following field of study:

One position at the rank of Assistant Professor or Lecturer in the following field of study:
«Traffic Engineering»

For all academic ranks, an earned doctorate from a recognized University is required.

Requirements for each academic rank depend on the candidate's years of academic experience, the research record and scientific contributions, involvement in teaching and in the development of high quality undergraduate and graduate curricula. The official languages of the University are Greek and Turkish. For the above position knowledge of Greek is necessary.

Holding a citizenship of the Republic of Cyprus is not a requirement.

The annual gross salary for these positions (including the 13th salary) is:

Assistant Professor	(Scale A13-A14)	€56,905.42 - €76,747.19
Lecturer	(Scale A12-A13)	€48,057.36 - €70,383.17

Interested individuals should submit their application both in printed form (two (2) hardcopies) and in digital form (stored on two (2) compact disks (CD), documents should be in PDF (Portable Document Format) or Word), by **Monday, 26th of September 2011**. The application must include the following items:

- I A letter stating the academic rank or ranks for which the applicant is interested in, the field of study and the date when he/she may be able to assume duties in the event of selection.
- II A Curriculum Vitae.
- III A brief summary of previous work and a statement of plans for future research (up to 1500 words).
- IV A list of publications.
- V Copies of the three most representative publications.
- VI Copies of degree certificates should be scanned and included in the CDs.

In addition, the applicants must ask three academic referees to send recommendation letters directly to the University. The names and addresses of these referees must be submitted along with the application, since additional confidential information may be sought. The letters of recommendation must be received by the University by **Monday, 26th of September 2011.**

The Curriculum Vitae and the statement of previous work and plans should be written in Greek or in Turkish and in one international language, preferably English.

If candidates have had letters of recommendation send to the University of Cyprus in the past three years, they have the option of requesting from the Selection Committee to use the already submitted recommendation letters. Such request should be stated in their cover letter.

Individuals interested in applying for more than one fields of study, must submit a separate application, including all items mentioned at points I – VI.

Applications and other documents submitted in the past **will not be considered and must be re-submitted.**

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
