17 CRPF AWARDS FOR UCY RESEARCHERS

Lecturer Michael Lombardo and Research Associate Stelios Timotheou win the Young Researchers Award

The University of Cyprus (UCY) announces that the Lecturer Michael Lombardo (Department of Psychology) and the Research Associate Stelios Timotheou (KOIOS Research and Innovation Center of Excellence) have been awarded the Young Researchers Award by the Cyprus Research Promotion Foundation (CRPF).

The Award Ceremony for the 11th Cyprus Innovation Awards took place on Wednesday, November 29th 2017, at Hilton Cyprus, Nicosia, during which the awards were presented by H.E. the President of the Republic Mr. Nicos Anastasiades.
