Dr. Gina Cohen started her gas career when she established the local branches of British Gas Israel & Palestine in 1998, and worked in the capacity of Manager of External Affairs & Business Development until the company closed its operations in the area in 2006. Immediately upon the closure of BG's local branch, Gina was hired as consultant to BG's Palestinian partners, CCC a multinational corporation with a turnover of more than \$10 billion a year to continue managing the partnerships' gas operations in Israel and the PA. In these capacities, Gina was involved in all aspects of the gas chain from exploration & development to gas sales negotiations, to representing the company in the legislation of all of Israel's gas related laws, strategic thinking and corporate affairs. Gina has worked as a consultant to the Israel Ministry of Energy on matters relating to: writing the Natural Gas Guide Book; permitting process for the construction and siting of all the natural gas facilities; natural gas storage and gas pricing regulations. Gina has managed due diligence projects ranging from the establishment of natural gas generation power plants in Palestine to floating LNG (FLNG) projects in the US. Gina lectures on Natural Gas Law and Economy at the Technion University's M. Sc. Graduate program for Petroleum Engineers and is the author of the Hebrew-English energy lexicon (www.hebrewenergy.com) used by all professionals in the Israeli petroleum sector.
