Guidelines:

- I. Students who will participate in the graduation ceremony should be gather at the above meeting place/lectures halls at exactly **6:45 p.m.** University administrators will be there as well, to guide you and to place you in the correct order, exactly as you will proceed onto the ceremony stage. The names of the graduates will be announced by the Chairpersons of the departments, thus gathering early enough is very important to be able to take the correct order in which your name will be announced. Graduates interested in taking group photos with their fellow students **are kindly requested to arrive at the assembly rooms at 6:15 p.m.**

- II. All graduates will take their exact ceremony seats at **7:30 p.m.** The designated attendants will guide you along the route you will follow to take your graduation ceremony seats and the route you will follow to go on stage.

- III. During the Ceremony, photos taking, video recording, the use of mobile phones, smoking and moving around, should be avoided. You are also kindly requested to inform your guests to maintain a respectful and discreet presence during the ceremony. Moreover, people who will accompany children are kindly requested to supervise them (prevent them from moving around the stage, the aisles, the host area, and the official guests' seats) to avoid the disturbance of the ceremonial process.
- IV. Entry to the event area for the invited guests will only be permitted upon **presentation of a valid QR entry Code**, which is issued electronically through the Graduation Declaration system.
- V. Attendees are requested to comply with the instructions of security personnel, including showing personal belongings where this is deemed necessary for security reasons. Refusal to comply with inspection procedures will result in immediate denial of entry. **Please note that the use of noise-making devices (e.g. air horns) is strictly prohibited.**
- VI. Please do not bring large personal items with you, such as bags, etc., since you will not be allowed to have them with you at the ceremony venue or leave them in the assembly rooms that you will be gather initially. **You will not return to the assembly rooms after the ceremony.**

- IX. During the entrance of the members of the University Senate and other academics in the ceremony area, you are kindly requested to stand up from your seat. The same applies and during the end of the ceremony and the exit of the academics from the ceremony area.
