

Curriculum Vitae: **Dr. Pavlos Philippou**

Architect engaged in practice, teaching and research, whose general interests encompass the history and theory of both architecture and urbanism, as well as the ways spatial design strategies contribute to the contemporary city in creative ways. More specifically, the work focusses on the transactional agency of architecture – via a theoretically and historically informed understanding of its disciplinary autonomy – in the life of cities.

Following a brief spell in London, Pavlos has been working with *J+A Philippou architects-engineers* since 1999, while his design work has been published and exhibited internationally – especially a winning European entry. Further to his professional engagement at J+A Philippou, Pavlos is the current President of the *Cypriot Planning Board*, works as adjunct faculty at both University of Nicosia and University of Cyprus, as well as publishes regularly in peer-reviewed journals (currently developing a paper and acting as co-editor for a *Journal of Architecture* Special Edition). Beyond these, he has participated in design juries-reviews, has led workshops, has acted in Diploma Committees and has delivered lectures in numerous universities around the world (mainly within the United Kingdom, but also in Australia, Cyprus and Greece). In the past, Pavlos has taught at London's Architectural Association School of Architecture (AA), where he completed all three of his degrees – namely, Diploma, M.A. (Housing & Urbanism, Distinction) and Ph.D.

Professional Practice

Registered architect with the *Cyprus Scientific and Technical Chamber (ETEK)* since 2000, while also a Member of the *Cyprus Architects Association* and an Alumni Member of the *Architectural Association School of Architecture*.

In practice, Pavlos is involved in numerous projects at various scales – ranging from small scale installations to large scale master-plans, as well as extensive consultation on the spatial domain of the built environment. Numerous of these projects are pursued with the office as the sole author, while many others are conducted via collaboration with international and/or local consultants. Some of these works have been published and exhibited internationally, but there are few distinctions on the CV in terms of architectural competitions – as Pavlos has intentionally abstained from participating in them since 2005 [the only two exceptions were a shortlisted entry for the Leventis Art Gallery (with David Chipperfield Architects, 2007) and a recent proposal for the New Cyprus Museum].

Planning Board

Pavlos is currently the *President of the Cypriot Planning Board*, for the period 1st July 2016 up to 31st December 2018. The Board is an independent governmental institutional body, with advisory duties and regulatory powers as to the state's high-end town planning policy.
