'LUCY', Laboratory of Urbanism, University of Cyprus, supported by the Architecture Lecture Series, of the Department of Architecture, University of Cyprus, organizes a seminar as part of the 'City and Social Justice'. The title of the seminar is:

Urgent Pedagogies: how to unlearn in architecture schools?

The aim of the seminar is to bring forward the need to revisit the pedagogical programs of professions such as Architecture. In order to address issues of injustice in the city, we firstly need to understand the role of architecture as a consolidation tool of the dominating powers. Then, a process of unlearning needs to take place. Urgent Pedagogies is an on-going project initiated by IASPIS, (Magnus Ericson and Pelin Tan), where Architecture is part of critical spatial practices, creating synergies with other material practices, such as visual arts. LUCY as well as the elective course, titled 'Architecture's Social Practices and their Political Agencies', taught by Socrates Stratis, focus on such processes of unlearning.

Pelin Tan, Magnus Ericson and Paulo Moreira will present their on-going work, in 15' interventions.
