

**Professor Daniel Shefer, PhD**

Professor Shefer is a Professor *Emeritus* and *ex-Dean* of the Faculty of Architecture and Town Planning at the Technion- Israel Institute of Technology, where he has taught since 1970. He is a graduate of the University of California at Berkeley (BLA), Harvard University (MCP) and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (PhD). Professor Shefer has also served as Director of the Transportation Research Institute at the Technion and as Senior Economist with the Urban and Regional Economics Division of the World Bank in Washington DC.

Professor Shefer's areas of expertise are: Urban and Regional Planning; Transportation Planning; Environmental Planning; Industrial Innovation; Technology Transfer; Modeling Industrial Location, Agglomeration Economies and Regional Economic growth. He has published widely in these fields - several books, over one hundred articles in various International scientific journals, and numerous research reports.

Professor Shefer Supervised over 80 PhD and Master theses.
