Description: Housing in many European countries has become unaffordable for many. The EU-funded RE-DWELL project will train 15 early-stage researchers (ESRs) in design planning and building, community participation, and policy and financing, providing them with the capacity to operate across fields and sectors, generating innovative solutions for the housing problem in the EU.
