GENERAL INFORMATION

Submission of applications:

Applications must be submitted electronically using the online application system http://webapps.leventis.ucy.ac.cy:7786/postgraduate_app/MNG_USER_en.login_frm by **Friday, 30th of May 2014**.

Applications must include the following:

1. A Curriculum Vitae
2. Certified copies of University degrees or confirmation of graduation (The certified copy of the degree should be submitted along with the Registration Form to the University of Cyprus at the latest)
3. Copies of Transcripts from all programs of study
4. A preliminary research proposal (up to 1500 words) that describes the candidate's proposed research topic. Specifically, the proposal should include:
 - The research questions and their significance
 - The proposed research methodology to be used in addressing the research questions
 - The important literature on the research topic

- A timetable for completing the PhD
5. The names and addresses of University Professors. The candidates should request letters of recommendation to be sent directly to the Coordinator of Postgraduate Studies of the Department. **Letters must bear an original signature and be submitted in a stamped envelope.** The Department may request additional confidential information from the referees. Alternatively, the reference letters could also be submitted electronically directly by the University Professors using the online application system.
 6. Submit proof of very good knowledge of the English language (test results and/or certificates obtained)

PhD Programme Fees:

The total programme fees for PhD students that hold a master's degree are €3.200.
