



**ANNOUNCEMENT OF VISITING ACADEMIC POSITION
DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL AND ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING
FALL SEMESTER 2026-2027**

The Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering invites expressions of interest for the filling of one (1) Visiting Professor position in the following areas of scientific interest. Each candidate is expected to have documented scientific and teaching experience in **three (3) or more** of the following areas:

- Protection and sustainable use of natural resources
- Environmental management systems and sustainability policies
- Environmental impact assessment and environmental design of projects
- Pollution prevention technologies and environmental remediation
- Water resources management and groundwater hydrology
- Solid and hazardous waste engineering and management, and material and energy recovery
- Environment, health, and safety
- Energy, climate change, and sustainable development
- Building energy efficiency and energy design of the built environment
- Applications of artificial intelligence (machine learning), data analytics, and digital twins in environmental, energy, and climate systems

Duties:

The selected candidate will contribute to the teaching of undergraduate and/or postgraduate courses of the Department, supervise student projects, and participate in the research and academic activities of the Section.

Required Qualifications:

Candidates should possess:

- A degree in Engineering (e.g. Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Chemical Engineering), from an accredited University
- A PhD in a relevant field, from an accredited University
- Documented research activity and scientific publications
- Teaching experience in higher education
- Ability to teach in both Greek and English

Additional Qualifications (Considered an Asset):

- **International academic experience and research productivity**, participation in research projects, and the ability to link teaching with contemporary scientific and applied developments.
- **Experience or research interest in the use of modern digital tools, data analysis techniques and/or Artificial Intelligence methods** in environmental, energy, or climate-related applications.
- **Experience in the use and analysis of data** (e.g. field data, measurements, models) to support understanding, prediction, or decision-making in complex systems.

The official languages of the University of Cyprus are Greek and Turkish, but teaching in English is also possible. For these positions, excellent knowledge of Greek and/or English is required.

Applicants do not need to be citizens of the Republic of Cyprus but must be physically present in Cyprus during the semester, as teaching is continuous (1–3 times per week) and class schedules can NOT be changed.



Duration – Status:

The position is for one academic semester, in accordance with the needs of the Department and the applicable institutional framework.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:

Visiting Academics must reside in Cyprus on a full-time basis during their employment and should ensure that this is feasible before applying. Submission of an application implies acceptance of this condition, which must be explicitly stated in the letter of interest.

The successful candidate must have obtained the necessary leave of absence (sabbatical or unpaid leave) from their home institution.

Visiting Professors are employed full-time, corresponding on average to 9 teaching hours per week).

For the employment of Professor, for teaching in any of the programmes, candidates shall hold an equivalent rank in other Universities (Academic Institutions),

Monthly gross salaries (subject to change) are as follows:

Visiting Professor € 4.134,57

Salaries may be adjusted according to any general increases or decreases imposed by the State. A 13th salary will be paid proportionally to the employment period within the year.

Appointment to the positions is subject to the availability of funding. The Department reserves the right not to fill the positions if the teaching schedule changes or if the applications received do not meet its needs.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

The following must be included (in Greek or English):

1. Online Application Form (available on the above website after account creation and login), including detailed information on the applicant's qualifications, the academic fields in which the applicant wishes to teach, a concise description of teaching and research experience, as well as a statement of interest specifying areas of scholarly expertise.
2. Full Curriculum Vitae.
3. Copies of recognized academic degrees.
4. A cover letter demonstrating the candidate's suitability for the specific position.

Shortlisted candidates may be invited to an interview, for which they will be notified after the submission deadline.

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Selected candidates must later provide certified copies of degrees—either by the Ministry of Education, Sports and Youth (for degrees from private institutions in Cyprus) or by the issuing authority (for foreign universities).

The total size of the application, including attachments, must not exceed 20 MB.
Application deadline: **May 8th 2026, 14:00** (Cyprus time).

Selection will be made by the competent collective bodies of the Department.
