The Department of Classics and Philosophy of the University of Cyprus would like to announce one (1) vacant part time position in the capacity of a Special Scientist – *Research*, in the project “Generic Interactions in Persius’ *Satires*» (acronym GIPSar)”, which is funded by the Research Committee of the University of Cyprus (University of Cyprus Internal Research Programmes).

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES: The Special Scientist will collaborate with the Principal Investigator of the research programme Associate Professor Spyridon Tzounakas to implement deliverables of the project (e.g. collection and processing of material and essays pertaining to Persius and more generally to Roman satire; preparation of an annotated bibliography on both Persius and the literary interactions in Latin literature; presentations of works in progress in various research seminars and conferences; submission and publication of articles in international scientific journals; preparation of an international conference on the subject “Generic Interfaces in Persius’ *Satires*”; collection of paper contributions, review and selection for edited volume; submission of the manuscript to an editorial house)

NECESSARY QUALIFICATIONS: PhD in Latin

TERMS OF CONTRACT

The employment of the Special Scientist will be with a contract. The duration of the employment will be for two (2) years, from 2 October 2023 to 30 September 2025. The monthly gross salary will be €1.885,70. From this amount employee contributions to the various governmental funds shall be deducted. There is no provision for 13th Salary.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

All applicants are requested to submit the following information:

- i. Letter of interest for the position in question
- ii. Full CV in English
- iii. Copies and detailed transcripts of qualifications
- iv. Names and contact details of at least three referees – at least two of them must be academics – who can provide reference letters for the candidate
