Wet souls and burning nerves: some considerations on descriptions of inner processes between theory and bodily experience

Περίληψη διάλεξης:

Ancient medical and philosophical authors developed various theories to explain the processes of cognition, emotion and perception, many of them involving the concept of the soul, later also the nerves and the brain. At first sight, such theories imply a departure from bodily experience, which seems to be central for earlier descriptions of what we may call inner processes, especially in the Homeric epics. But is the opposition between experience and theory really so clear? This paper will discuss a number of examples from the pre-Socratics, the Corpus Hippocraticum, Plato and Apollonius of Rhodes that refer to theoretical concepts in a way that allows for an association with bodily experience, arguing that these two categories are not as sharply distinguished as one might expect.
