Organisation

- · gives appropriate directions and instructions
- gets students involved in discussion
- · presents material in a well organised way
- makes good use of handouts

Feedback

- provides meaningful and adequate feedback
- makes constructive and helpful comments on written work
- returns work promptly

• Knowledge of subject

- has command of subject material
- stresses important material
- · gives relevance of subject matter

• Responsiveness

- responsive to student needs and abilities
- adjusts pace of teaching to meet class needs
- readily accessible outside class
- sensitive to feelings and problems of individual students

Communications

- has clear and readable PowerPoint presentation
- clear and understandable in explanations
- · writes legibly on whiteboard
- stimulates students to think independently
