



# Amalia Arvaniti

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*Amalia Arvaniti (Ph.D., Cambridge 1991) is Professor of English Language and Linguistics at Radboud University, Netherlands. She had previously held research and teaching appointments at the University of Kent, UC San Diego, Cambridge, Oxford, Edinburgh, and the University of Cyprus, where she was an Assistant Professor (1994-2001). Amalia is one of the pioneers of Laboratory Phonology, which relies on experimental research methods to test linguistic models of sound structure. Her research, which focuses on the cross-linguistic study of prosody, has been widely published and cited, and has led to notable paradigm-shifts in our understanding of intonation and rhythm; in the period 2019-2024 this research is supported by an Advanced ERC grant titled [SPRINT](#) (ERC-ADG-835263). Additional research interests include the study of bilingualism, diglossia, and sociophonetics.*
