Anna Roussou (PhD University of London/UCL) is currently Professor of Linguistics at the Department of Philology, University of Patras. Her prior appointments include the University of Cyprus (1998-2001) where she held a position as an Assistant Professor and University of Wales, Bangor (1992-1998) where she had a Lectureship in Linguistics. Her research is on theoretical linguistics, mainly on syntax and its interfaces with semantics and the lexicon. The topics of her research include sentential complementation, the left periphery of the clause, and the properties of the subject. She has published extensively in journals and book chapters. Her publications also include the following books: *Syntactic Change* (2003, joint work with Ian Roberts), *Complementizers* (2006, in Greek) and a textbook on *Syntax* (in Greek, open access). She has also served as Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs at the University of Patras and is currently Vice-President for Research at the Hellenic Open University (since 2017).
