### **SPECIAL SCIENTIST POSITION**

The Department of English Studies at the University of Cyprus invites applications for one Special Scientist position in Linguistics for the Fall Semester 2017 – 2018 pending final approval and funding by the University authorities.

#### TEACHING REQUIREMENTS

The successful candidate will be required to teach ENG 350 EFL Teaching Methodology.

#### EMPLOYMENT TERMS

Special Scientist remuneration is 55 euro per teaching hour and paid employment is for 15 weeks. Teaching duties begin on September 4<sup>th</sup>, ending no later than December 31<sup>st</sup>, depending on the final exam. Payment is made as follows: €55 per hour x teaching hours x 15 weeks for the Fall Semester 2017-18.

#### QUALIFICATIONS

The successful candidate will be required to teach and guide students. She or he will also administer and mark the final exam for the course she or he will teach.

#### APPLICATION

Applicants should hold a PhD on a relevant subject.

Applicants should submit the following:

- I. Letter of application,
- II. Curriculum Vitae,
- III. Copies of degrees and transcripts. The successful candidate(s) will be asked to submit certified copies from the Ministry of Education of Cyprus (if degrees were acquired in Cyprus) or from the respective institution abroad,
- IV. Two representative publications

If applying for the first time to the Department, applicants must also arrange for two academic referees to send letters of recommendation directly to it (see below). The names and addresses of these referees must be submitted with the application.

In case an applicant is employed in the public or wider public sector of the Republic of Cyprus, she/he must obtain permission to work at the University from the appropriate Department/Ministry, or wider public sector authority.
