

## SPECIAL SCIENTIST POSITIONS

The Department of English Studies at the University of Cyprus invites applications for up to three (3) Special Scientist positions in Translation for the Fall Semester 2017/18 (September – December 2017), pending final approval and funding by the University authorities.

### TEACHING REQUIREMENTS

The successful candidate(s) will be required to teach:

- Two (2) elective courses in any area of Translation Studies
- One (1) tutorial for the undergraduate compulsory course ENG 270 TRANSLATION METHODOLOGY (intended as translation labs for translation exercises)

### EMPLOYMENT TERMS

Remuneration is 55 Euro per teaching hour for PhD holders and 36 Euro per teaching hour for MA holders. Teaching duties start September 4<sup>th</sup> and ending no later than December 31<sup>st</sup> depending on the final exam. The paid employment is for 15 weeks throughout the Fall semester 2016/17. Payment is made as follows: €55 or €36 per hour X teaching hours X 15 weeks for the Fall Semester.

### QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates applying to teach the elective courses must hold a PhD in a relevant field. Those applying to teach the tutorials must hold at least an MA in Translation. All applicants must have excellent command of both English and Greek. Interested applicants should state which course(s) they would be willing to teach and demonstrate their suitability for each. Applicants do not necessarily need to be citizens of the Republic of Cyprus. Experience in teaching translation courses (both theoretical and practical) will be an asset.

### APPLICATION

Applicants must submit:

1. A letter of application, stating **a)** their interest for the position, **b)** the course(s) they would be willing to teach, and **c)** indicative titles for elective courses
2. Curriculum Vitae, with full contact details
3. Copies of degrees and transcripts

The successful candidate(s) will be asked to submit certified copies from the Ministry of Education of Cyprus (if degrees were acquired in Cyprus) or from the respective institution abroad.
