The Lab consists of workstations equipped with the latest software programmes that enable students to

- enhance their ability to use technology and tools for teaching purposes, curriculum and course design, lesson planning and classroom management as well as active research,
- get acquainted with electronic tools that support the design and administration of language tests,
- work with oral and written corpora, information and communication technology (online resources, presentation software, virtual learning environments),
- conduct research regarding teaching material design, Computer-Assisted Language Learning (CALL), teacher development, language testing and assessment as well as translation for their own projects both at BA and MA level (take-home and final exams, theses),
- get acquainted with Computer Assisted Translation (CAT)-tools such as translation memories and online terminological databases,
- exercise their skills in translation-related software such as subtitling software and digital text-processing tools,
- keep up with the latest developments in machine translation.

Access to the Lab is provided to all students who take relevant compulsory and elective courses in the Theoretical & Applied Linguistics section and the Translation Studies section of the BA programme of the Department of English Studies, as well as to all MA students of Linguistics, TESOL and Translation.
