## THE SCHOOL IS RANKED AMONG THE TOP 15 GLOBALLY IN UNL GLOBAL RESEARCH RANKING OF ACTUARIAL SCIENCE AND RISK MANAGEMENT & INSURANCE

*The recent results of the UNL Global Research Ranking of Actuarial Science and Risk Management & Insurance, rank our School 15<sup>th</sup> globally in Business School RMI Ranking – JRI for the period 2015-2019.*

An important distinction for the School of Economics and Management of the University of Cyprus, which is ranked among the top Business Schools globally in recent [UNL Global Research Rankings of Actuarial Science and Risk Management & Insurance](#) of the University of Nebraska – Lincoln!

Specifically, our School is ranked 15<sup>th</sup> globally (4<sup>th</sup> in Europe) in the Business School RMI Rankings – JRI, for the period 2015-2019, which counts research publications in JRI (*Journal of Risk and Insurance*), the leading risk and insurance journal.

In addition, the School is ranked 31<sup>st</sup> globally (12<sup>th</sup> in Europe) in the RMI & Actuarial Science Rankings - JRI, IME, NAAJ, ASTIN, SAJ, which counts research publications in 5 leading journals in the fields of risk, insurance and actuarial science (*Journal of Risk and Insurance*, *Insurance: Mathematics and Economics*, *ASTIN Bulletin: The Journal of the International Actuarial Association*, *Scandinavian Actuarial Journal*).

The Actuarial Science Program in the Department of Finance in the College of Business of the University of Nebraska at Lincoln (UNL) has set up a database to track all papers published since 1990 in the above journals. Rankings are provided for the top 20 North American and the top 50 worldwide business and non-business schools respectively according to the cumulative number of their respective faculties' publications in these journals.

The School of Economics and Management of the University of Cyprus, would like to congratulate the Associate Professor of the Department of Accounting and Finance, Andreas Milidonis, for his great contribution to this important distinction of the School, through his recent research activity.
