

## **Tasos S. Anastasiou**

Tasos graduated with first-class honours from the London School of Economics & Political Science (LSE) in Economics, Accounting & Finance, earning prizes based on academic performance in each year of his studies. He is a Fellow member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England & Wales and holds the Advanced Corporate Finance Qualification from the Chartered Institute for Securities & Investment.

His career commenced with a 3-year tenure at PwC, predominantly in management consultancy, before moving into an Investment Banking firm where he gained valuable experience in company valuations, financial analysis, and mergers & acquisitions. Tasos then assumed the CFO role in a private company for about 4 years, shaping its financial and strategic planning. For the following 11 years, he held the position of CEO at Galatariotis Group of Companies, with activities in the Construction Industry, Building Materials, Hotels and Real Estate, concurrently serving as an Executive Director for the Group's publicly listed entities.

In the subsequent 5-year period Tasos served as the CEO of Trading Point Group, a leading global online trading/brokerage firm with licensed entities in the US, UK, Australia, Dubai and Cyprus, leading the development and execution of TP's long-term strategy and ensuring the group positioned effectively towards the challenging opportunities ahead. Deciding that this journey had come full circle, he is now a Private Equity Investor and Strategic Advisor, capitalising on his experience at the helm of diverse organizations and industries. Since January 2024 he is the Chairman of the University of Cyprus Council.

In addition to his executive roles, Tasos held various governance positions, depicted by his directorial position at Cyprus Telecommunications Authority and his seven-year stint as a non-Executive Director at A. Zorbas & Sons Public Company Ltd, where he chaired the Remuneration and Audit Committees. A holder of the Diploma on Company Directorship from the Institute of Directors he was also a member of the National Economy and Competitiveness Council since its inception in 2018 until 2024.
