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GENERAL INFORMATION

The University of Cyprus is accepting applications for the following postgraduate programmes for the **Fall Semester of the academic year 2025/2026 with admission on September 2025.**

Applications can be submitted **ONLY electronically** using the online application system of the University of Cyprus by **March 31, 2025 at 12 noon. Applications submitted on paper will not be accepted.**

The language of instruction for the above postgraduate programmes is Greek, except otherwise stated [here](#).

REQUIRED SUPPORTING CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS

The online applications should include the following:

1. **Curriculum Vitae.**
2. **Recognised University Degrees** (Master's and Bachelor's level) or **a certificate of expected graduation** in the month preceding enrolment in the postgraduate programme. (In case of admission to a programme, certified copies of degrees must be submitted at the University no later than the acceptance date of the place).
3. **University Transcripts** as appropriate.
4. **A short statement** (max. two pages) of the student's research goals and interests.
5. **Letters of recommendation: The names and addresses of at least two (2) referees (University Professors)** familiar with the candidate and his/her academic performance. In your application, you will only need to include the names and e-mail addresses of the evaluators. Reference letters are submitted electronically directly by the University Professors using the online application system. Please note that the Department may request additional confidential information.
(Some departments require three (3) reference letters to be submitted with the application, so before submitting your application, please visit the web page of the department to verify the number of reference letters required).
6. **Certificate of English language proficiency** (if you are interested in studying in an English-speaking postgraduate programme or a programme requiring English language proficiency):
 - In accordance with the Cyprus Agency of Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Higher Education (CYQAA), for admission to postgraduate programmes taught in the English language, candidates should provide a certificate of their knowledge of English.
 - For postgraduate programmes candidates are required to have a certification for "Very Good Knowledge" of English at level B2-C1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).
 - Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) corresponds to the following specific reference frameworks for international examinations, according to the official pages of the organizations offering these examinations. Indicatively, a score of 5.5 – 6.5 corresponds to knowledge of level B2 (Lower), while score 8.5-9 is level C2 (Proficiency).
 - Due to some scores only remaining valid for two years, if you apply using a certificate gained over two years ago, you will need to retake the test.

- Interested candidates coming from third countries can also take the Password Test (Password Skills Test Plus), ensuring an overall score of at least 5.5, in order to be granted a permit to enter the Republic of Cyprus (Decision 91.387/2021 of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Cyprus, which enters into force on 01.12.2022).
7. Other certificates and verifications that they will help the evaluation committee to assess your application, such as employment verifications, etc.
 8. **FOR DOCTORAL APPLICATIONS:** A preliminary research proposal for a PhD place (if this is stated in the department's regulations).

Maximum tuition fees for a PhD degree are €9.000.</p>

In addition to graduate tuition, a clinical practicum fee of €1.000 is charged in the **Applied Programme in School Psychology Master & PhD programme**, in order to cover expenses for clinical supervision services provided by Registered Professional Psychologists.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The University of Cyprus offers scholarships to Master degree and PhD students. These scholarships are awarded based on the academic performance and the socio-economic status of the student.

1. **Scholarships from the Academic Departments of the University of Cyprus**: The academic Departments of the University of Cyprus offer scholarships to their postgraduate students from their own income. For more information please, contact directly the Departments.
2. **Scholarships for Siblings or First Degree Relatives or Married Partners**: The University of Cyprus awards scholarships for partial coverage of fees to new and existing postgraduate students who are studying in a conventional Master's or PhD programme of the University of Cyprus and are siblings or first-degree relatives or couples. In order for the scholarships to be granted, the students must fall into the following categories and provide the necessary supporting documents and certificates that will be requested by the University of Cyprus.
 - **Siblings**: when two or more siblings (or other first-degree relatives) are simultaneously studying in a conventional Master's or PhD programme, a 20% scholarship is granted in the instalments of the semester tuition fees for each student.
 - **Couples**: in the event that married couples of students are simultaneously studying in a conventional Master's or PhD programme, a 20% scholarship is granted in the instalments of the semester tuition fees for each student.

Note: *Students in Self-Funded Programmes are excluded from the scholarships award.*
3. **Scholarships for staff of the Ministry of Defense and the National Guard**: The University of Cyprus provides four (4) scholarships to the personnel of the Cyprus Ministry of Defense and/or Cyprus National Guard. A prerequisite for the grant of the scholarship is to secure a place in a postgraduate programme of the University of Cyprus. Each scholarship will cover the second 50% of the tuition fees (considering that applicants have already paid the first 50%).
4. **Scholarships to students - holders of the EU Disability card**: The University of Cyprus awards partial tuition scholarship to new students with disabilities who hold the European Disability Card and are studying in a Master's or Doctoral degree programme, Conventional or Self-financed. The University of Cyprus grants a 20% scholarship on the semester's tuition fee instalments, with the exception of the tuition fee deposit paid by the student upon acceptance of the place. **Additional information.**
5. **Scholarships in memory of MICHALIS (MIKE) POLYDOROU* for Master/PhD Level Students of the Department of Computer Science – Department of Computer Science**: The Department of Computer Science will accept applications at the beginning of each academic year for two tuition-fee scholarships each for the sum of €5125 (or €4.000/€6.500 depending on the fees of the program). Eligible candidates are Master/PhD level students of the Department of Computer Science who are carrying out or will carry out their master's or doctoral thesis on any topic of Computer Science. Applicants are required to submit electronically the relevant **application** to the Department of Computer Science together with all the necessary certificates at cs@ucy.ac.cy, **from 10.9.2025 until 15.10.2025**. 6. **Scholarship “Andreas Pitsillides” for incoming graduate students at the Master level admitted at the department of Computer Science of the University of Cyprus during the Fall Semester 2025/2026 – Department of Computer Science:**

The Department of Computer Science accepts applications from new graduate students for a tuition-fees scholarship for the sum of €5125. Eligible candidates are Master-level students of the Department of Computer Science who have been admitted for their studies during the Fall Semester (2025-26). The criteria for the scholarship are the following:

(a) *The recipient of the scholarship must be a Cypriot citizen and*

(b) *come from a low-income family, based on the criteria and mechanisms of the University of Cyprus.*

Applicants are required to submit electronically the relevant **application** to the Department of Computer Science together with all the necessary certificates at cs@ucy.ac.cy, **from 10.9.2025 until 17.10.2025**. 7. **Scholarships from Chevron Cyprus Ltd for Master’s Studies in Selected Engineering Fields - Faculty of Engineering (Departments of Electrical and Computer Engineering, Mechanical and Manufacturing Engineering, Civil and Environmental Engineering):**

The School of Engineering at the University of Cyprus announces the call for applications for three scholarships, funded through a financial donation by Chevron Cyprus Ltd, amounting to a total of €15,375, for the full coverage of tuition fees for Master’s studies in selected engineering fields, as follows: (a) One scholarship of €5,125 for a Master’s program in the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering, (b) One scholarship of €5,125 for a Master’s program in the Department of Mechanical and Manufacturing Engineering, (c) One scholarship of €5,125 for a Master’s program in the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering. It is noted that the scholarship exclusively covers tuition fees and does not include any living expenses or related costs. INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS - APPLICATION FOR A VISA

Entry permit visa of postgraduate students from non-EU countries

All students from non-EU countries require a visa to enter the Republic of Cyprus.

Once the evaluation process of your application has been completed and the decision to offer you a place on a postgraduate programme has been made, you will be informed by the International Students and Staff Office about the documents required for the issuance of a visa.

Once all the required documents and payments have been received, the University of Cyprus, through the International Students and Staff Office, will submit the student's documents to the competent authority for examination of the visa application.

Relevant information can be found in the Department's website https://www.ucy.ac.cy/bpa/people/academic-staff/?lang=en</p> <p>For the Fall Semester of the academic year 2025-2026, the Department of Business and Public Administration will offer one (1) full scholarship and two (2) partial scholarships to new applicants that will apply for admission to the PhD program in Business Administration.</p> <p><i>Full scholarship</i> The full scholarship will cover: (i) funding of 12000 euro per year (12 months X 1000 euro) for a period of four (4) years and (ii) covering the tuition fees for the whole duration of the Doctoral Programme totalling 4000 euro, as defined by the relevant procedures of the University of Cyprus. This scholarship will be given to a doctoral student who will study on a full-time basis throughout the duration of the four years of his/her studies, while he is not allowed to be employed at the same time in any other work during this period. The doctoral student who will receive the full scholarship will sign a declaration letter that, during the period of receiving the scholarship, he/she will not be employed in any other organization on a full-time basis. In addition, the doctoral student will have an obligation to work four (4) hours per week in the Department of Business and Public Administration.</p> <p><i>Partial scholarships</i> The partial scholarships will cover the tuition fees only for the whole duration of the PhD Programme, totalling of 4000 euro, as defined by the relevant procedures of the University of Cyprus.</p> <p><i>Terms and conditions</i> The scholarships will be awarded on a competitive basis, taking into consideration the performance of the candidate in his/her previous</p>

	<p>degrees, previous work experience, and the quality of the research proposal. The Council of the Department of Business and Public Administration will decide on the renewal of the scholarship based on the student's academic performance, following a recommendation by the Departmental Graduate Studies Committee and his/her Research Advisor.</p> <p>A doctoral student registered in the Research or Writing Stage, after passing his/her comprehensive exams, must submit at the end of the academic year a Progress Report to the Department's Graduate Committee, in which he/she will describe his/her progress during the academic year.
