Evangelia Matthopoulou holds a Ph.D. in Modern and Contemporary History from the University of Cyprus (2016) and MA in History of International Relations from LSE (2008). Following her Ph.D studies, she undertook post-doctoral research as a fellow at Bank of Cyprus Cultural Foundation on the project POST-DOC/0916/0231 “The business elite of modern Cyprus, 1878-1959” co-financed by the European Regional Development Fund and the Republic of Cyprus through the Research and Innovation Foundation.
