REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS AND SKILLS

- BSc or MSc in a related field, e.g., political science, sociology, history, economics
- Experience with data management, including Excel and other statistical software programs
- Research experience and demonstrable ability to quickly collect and analyse information
- Excellent knowledge of English (written/verbal)
- Team spirit and working well with others

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collect and analyse data related to prosecutions, commissions of inquiry and apologies in the aftermath of the 2008 economic crisis from selected countries
- Review specific bodies of literature exploring the politics of accountability and crisis management
- Contribute to the design/analysis of a survey (experiment)

The position is on a contract basis of one year (part time), and is renewable. The hourly rate is equal to €11,6 (gross amount). Employee contributions will be deducted from the above amount. The position does not include a 13th salary bonus.
