

CALL FOR AN ACADEMIC VISITOR

The Department of French and European Studies accepts applications for filling one (1) Academic Visitor position in the rank of Lecturer or Assistant Professor, depending on qualifications, for the Spring Semester 2020-2021 (15/01/2021 - 31/05/2021) for the following courses:

1. **GES 310 - Language, History and Society**
2. **GES 100 - Introduction to linguistics**
3. **GES 222 - FLE and popular cultures**

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Teaching: Each lesson is offered for three hours per week (twice a week, eg Monday-Thursday or Tuesday-Friday, for 1½ hour each time).

All levels require a doctoral degree from a recognized University in a field related to the course.

The language of instruction is **French**.

The filling of the position is subject to the availability of funding.

The candidates do not have to be citizens of the Republic of Cyprus.

In case the selected person is employed in a public or wider public sector, he / she must obtain a relevant permit from the competent Department / Ministry or a wider Public Sector, or has obtained a relevant permit (Sabbatical leave or unpaid leave) from the University from which it comes.

It is noted that Visiting Academics must be in Cyprus on a permanent basis during their period of employment and please ensure that this is possible before submitting their application. The submission of the application implies acceptance of the above provision and confirmation of acceptance should be included in the letter of expression of interest.

In case of emergency measures and inability to come to Cyprus, and if the courses will be done remotely, the above provision can be suspended.

It is also noted that, due to the Covid-19 pandemic, distance learning may exceptionally be conducted. Monthly gross earnings according to current data are calculated as follows:

Visitor Academic (Assistant Professor) € 3,122.10

Visitor Academic (Lecturer) € 2,723.17

Interested parties are kindly requested to submit:

1. Letter of interest for this position
2. Curriculum Vitae (including contact address and telephone number)
3. Copies of diplomas
4. Optional up to two letters of recommendation

Candidates may be asked for an oral interview.



The selected candidate will be invited to submit certified copies of diplomas from the Ministry of Education (in the case of diplomas from Private Schools / Universities in Cyprus) or from the Issuing Authority (in the case of Universities Abroad).
