PSY 301 EXPERIMENTAL PSYCHOLOGY METHODS (7 ECTS)

This course will provide students with the knowledge needed to design experiments and to collect, analyze, and interpret experimental data. During this course students will acquire skills in using the SPSS statistical package to analyze data and they will gain experience in preparing scientific manuscripts that follow the guidelines of the American Psychological Association (APA). Through in-class analyses and discussions of experiments from various concentrations of research in Psychology the course aims at promoting students' critical thinking.

PSY 713* Experimental Psychology (7.5 ECTS)

This graduate course aims at offering students advance knowledge as well as practical experience in the design, preparation, and implementation of computerized experiments in Psychology. The course will provide theoretical background on the logic of experimental design as well as in-depth knowledge regarding experimental designs that are commonly used in psychology today. Furthermore, students will be taught the basic principles of computer programming and will be trained in designing experiments with the E-Prime and Presentation software packages which are commonly used today for data collection in behavioral experiments within various fields of Psychology. Through individual assignments and a final project students are expected to gain experience in all stages of conducting research with personal computers.

PSY 632 Adolescence (7.5 ECTS)

This course will cover the main theories and research on cognitive, physiological, socio-emotional, moral, and personality development during adolescence. Furthermore, various problems faced by adolescents will be discussed. Factors contributing to the development of problematic behavior, emotional, social and academic problems will be emphasized. The importance of discussing various psychological and other problems faced by adolescents lies upon the fact that they are connected to extreme behaviors, such as suicide, criminal and aggressive behavior.

PSY 706 Neurophysiology (7.5 ECTS)

Human behaviour results both from natural (biological) as well as exogenous (psycho-social) factors. This course will examine the basic structure, organization and function of the human nervous system particularly as these affect or modify behaviour. We will specifically study the following topics: anatomy of the brain, spinal cord, peripheral nerves and muscles; structure and function of neurons; the effect of neuro-transmitters, hormones, and other endocrinological factors; as well as the interactions of these biological systems and their effects on behaviour. The neuro-physiological basis of specific behaviours such as sleep, reproduction, memory, aggression, communication as well as mental disorders will be studied in detail. In addition we will review current research projects and findings that relate to the above.

PSY 746 Social Psychology of Education (7.5 ECTS)

This course aims to discuss the socio-psychological bases of cross-cultural education. Students will have the opportunity to learn about the main theories of generation and decrease of prejudice, stereotypes and discrimination, as well as their application in educational settings. There will be discussions about the phenomenon of immigration through the minority and the majority perspective, and about the phenomenon of national conflicts, as well as the role that the educational system may play in peace consolidation, through the application of the discussed theories.

PSY 749 Qualitative research methods in Psychology (7.5 ECTS)

The aim of this course is to introduce and familiarize students with qualitative research methods in psychology, through theoretical review and empirical applications. The course will involve the study of qualitative research projects coming from the areas of social, developmental, educational, cognitive and clinical psychology. It will include the study of: 1) the epistemological principles of qualitative and quantitative methodology 2) principles and application of methods of data collection 3) analytical theoretical models and 4) organization, conduction and presentation in class of an original small research project.
