HIS 512 Receptions of Byzantium in Early Modern Europe 10 ECTS (MASTER LEVEL)

The purpose of this course is to consider the receptions of Byzantium by western Europeans for a few centuries after its fall, in 1453. Against the background of the ambiguous relationship between the Byzantine Empire and the kingdoms and empire of Western Europe, as well as Byzantium's privileged relationship with the Greek past, this course's purpose is to explore the ways in which Byzantium was received in Western Europe after it ceased to be a political entity.
