Fryni Kakoyianni-Doa is an Associate Professor of Linguistics and Didactics at the Department of French and European Studies at the University of Cyprus. She is the Chair of the Department of French and European Studies at the University of Cyprus. She is also the Acting Director of the Language Centre of the University of Cyprus.

Her fields of research include syntax and semantics, in particular the syntax of adverbs in French and Modern Greek, corpus linguistics, especially parallel corpora, as well as didactics and acquisition of French as a Foreign Language for speakers of Greek language. She is the head of the Open and Interdisciplinary Laboratory for Research in Methodology of Teaching/Learning Languages and Cultures Methodol Openlab.

She is also the scientific manager of the research project SOURCe (Searchable Online French-Greek Parallel Corpus for the University of Cyprus). She has published numerous articles and edited volumes on phrasal adverbs, prepositions, and other subjects regarding the use of parallel corpora, the acquisition and didactics of foreign languages (RUMAR).
