Concurrently, in the lobby of the Social Activities Building, there will be information booths from various language organizations (Aula Cervantes, British Council, Confucius Institute, Dante Alighieri Society, Goethe Institute, French Institute, Polish Embassy, Bilingual Association of Cyprus, School of Modern Greek, FEPAN, European Commission office in Cyprus) operating from 10:00 to 14:00 for a pleasant and creative day. Participants will have the opportunity to enter a Knowledge Contest with attractive prizes, while music in various languages will be played throughout the venue!

Additionally, students will have the opportunity to register and secure a spot to attend twenty-minute sample presentations by the experienced teaching staff from the Language Center, the School of Modern Greek, and the Confucius Institute. These presentations will provide a taste of the language and culture of their choice. The sample presentations will be offered in the following languages: English, French, Greek, Italian, Spanish, Chinese, Russian, Turkish, and Cypriot Sign Language.
