2.1.2 Rules for the election of two Academic Staff members to the Board of the Faculty 1994 and 2009

Under Regulation 36 of the University of Cyprus (Bodies of the University) Regulations 1994

1. The Chairperson of the Department shall convene a special meeting of the Board of the Department in writing, at which two representatives of the Department shall be elected to the Board of the Faculty.
2. The Board shall be in quorum when the number of members present exceeds half of the total number of its members. If a quorum is not present, the Chairperson of each Department shall convene a new meeting within 48 hours, and the procedure shall be repeated until a quorum is reached.
3. All members of the Board shall be entitled to nominate candidates at the meeting, whose names shall be listed alphabetically, and a secret ballot shall follow.
4. The election shall be held separately for the first and the second representatives. For the election of the first representative, the candidates shall be Professors or Associate Professors. Candidates may be from all ranks for the election of the second representative.
5. In both cases, the candidate who receives the most votes shall be elected. In the event of a tie, the election shall be decided by drawing lots.
6. The Chairperson of the Department shall promptly notify the Dean of the Faculty of the results of the election.
7. If a member of the Board of the Faculty (elected in accordance with these Rules) resigns before the expiration of his/her term of office, a new election shall be held for the remainder of the term.

The present Rules were approved by the Interim Governing Board at meeting No. 30, dated 13-15.04.1994, and were amended at meeting No. 115 of the Personnel and Regulations Committee, dated 17.12.2009.
