2.1.3 Rules for the election of three representatives from each Faculty as members of the Senate 1994

Under Regulation 22 of the University of Cyprus (Bodies of the University) Regulations 1994

- 1.** The Dean of the Faculty shall convene a special meeting of the Board of the Faculty, at which three representatives of the Faculty shall be elected to the Senate. The Dean of the Faculty shall notify the members of the Board of the Faculty in writing at least one week before the meeting.
- 2.** The Board shall be in quorum when the number of members present exceeds half of the total number of its members. If a quorum is not present, the Dean of the Faculty shall convene a new meeting within 48 hours, and the procedure shall be repeated until a quorum is reached.
- 3.** All members shall be entitled to nominate candidates at the meeting, whose names shall be listed alphabetically, and a secret ballot shall follow. Each member may vote for up to three candidates.
- 4.** The three candidates who receive the most votes shall be elected. In the event of a tie, the election shall be decided by drawing lots.
- 5.** The Dean shall promptly notify the Rector in writing of the results of the election.
- 6.** If a member of the Senate (elected in accordance with these Rules) resigns before the expiration of his/her term of office, a new election shall be held for the remainder of the term.

The present Rules were approved by the Interim Governing Board at meeting No. 30, dated 13-15.04.1994.
