



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The International School Psychology Association undertook an accreditation of the School Psychology program at the University of Cyprus, during the academic year 2013/14. The accreditation team was provided with comprehensive documentation about the program and two team members carried out a site visit in March 2014.

This report contains details about the nature and conduct of the accreditation, it comments on the program's content and delivery and provides an appraisal of the extent to which trainees completing it have met each of the ISPA standards for professional training in school psychology.

The overall conclusion is that the program has many excellent qualities, it enjoys a high status both within the university and the wider community and its trainees meet or exceed all of the ISPA accreditation standards. The recommendations contained in the report, those with the highest priority being marked with an asterisk, are advisory and designed to help the program to develop further in the next five years.

ISPA is therefore delighted to formally accredit the program until April 2019.
